- b) if so, the details of such consultation, including dates of meetings, correspondence exchanged, summary moved, and decisions taken thereon;
- c) if not, the reasons for not initiating or undertaking such consultation; and
- d) what steps, if any, are being taken by the Federal Government to consult the Provincial Government of Punjab in this regard and to consider the declaration of Kharian as a district?

- d) the measures taken during the last five years to restore and protect these waterways, including installation or expansion of wastewater treatment facilities, identification and sealing of illegal sewage connections, restoration of natural flow paths, removal of encroachments, and penalties imposed against violators; and
- e) whether the Government has prepared any comprehensive restoration plan for Islamabad's natural streams, including timelines, budget requirements, responsible agencies, water quality monitoring mechanisms and conversion of these polluted drains back into environmentally sustainable urban waterways?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) whether CDA has finalized the verification and processing of Built-Up-Property (BUP) files of the affectees of Sector C.15, Islamabad;
- b) if so, whether CDA/NADRA has scheduled or finalized the date of balloting for allotment of plots to BUP files holders;
- c) if the balloting has not yet been conducted, the date by which the balloting will be held; and
- d) whether CDA will issue allotment letter/plot numbers to successful applicants immediately after completion of balloting and if not, the reasons therefor?

- a) whether it is a fact that park situated opposite G-10/3, Khan Market, Islamabad has not been renovated for long time; and
- b) if so, the reasons thereof and time by which the said park is likely to be renovated?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics control be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that millions of Pakistani expatriates residing in Saudi Arabia pay substantial amounts in lacs of rupees to obtain visas, and are further required to pay 8,000 to 9,000 Saudi Riyals for visa renewal alongside approximately 5,000 Riyals to the sponsor (kafeel), which consumes nearly their entire annual earnings; and
- b) the steps being taken by the Government to take up the matter with the Saudi authorities to provide relief to the underprivileged Pakistani workers?
