170. * MR. ANJUM AQEEL KHAN

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that the establishment of 250 beds National Police Hospital is under construction in the Sector H-12, Islamabad;
- b) whether it is also a fact that the above said hospital has various wards including facilities for treating weapon related injuries and providing physiotherapy services; and
- c) if the answer to part (a) and (b) above are in affirmative, when it will be completed and made functional?

171. * MS. MUSSARAT RAFIQUE MAHESAR

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state the scope, geographical coverage, funding and implementation mechanism of the Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) deworming initiatives, including the number of beneficiaries covered to date and the health outcome indicators being used to assess its effectiveness?

172. * MS. NEELUM

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) the detail of commercial and residential projects were approved by the Capital Development Authority (CDA) during the year 2026;
- b) what is the expected revenue from them and what conditions have been imposed for civic amenities in these projects; and
- c) whether according to recent CDA's record, thirty-seven projects were approved in the year 2026?

173. * MS. SHAHIDA BEGUM

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) whether National Database and Registration Authority (NADRA) maintains verified family and ancestral records Family Tree (شجرۂ نسب) of citizens in its database;
- b) whether, where such information is already available and accessible to an authorized officer, it is necessary for a citizen to again submit attested documents, affidavits or certificates containing the same information for issuance or renewal of an identity document or other Government service;
- c) whether the Government has reviewed the documents, attestations and certifications presently required from citizens despite the relevant information already being available with NADRA or other Government departments; and
- d) whether the Government proposes to adopt a policy that citizens shall not be required to submit or attest information already verified and accessible through official Government databases, except where specifically required by law or for security purposes; if so, the details thereof?

Will the Minister for Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

- a) whether Pakistan Television Corporation (PTV) and Radio Pakistan are operating under profit or loss at present;
- b) the total financial losses/surpluses reported during the FY-2024-25; and
- c) the steps being taken by the Government to reform and modernize these public broadcasters?

Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state:

- a) the existing policy governing cancellation, refund and compensation of air tickets by domestic airlines, particularly in cases of delayed, rescheduled or cancelled flights, indicating the legal and regulatory basis thereof;
- b) whether it is a fact that passengers were previously entitled to a full refund where a flight was delayed by two hours, whereas the permissible delay for such refund has subsequently been extended to five hours; if so, the reasons and justification therefor, together with the authority under which such revision was made;
- c) the number of complaints received against domestic airlines regarding delayed flights, denial or delay in refunds, and cancellation charges during the last three years, together with the action taken thereon; and
- d) whether the Government proposes to review the existing refund and compensation policy to safeguard passengers from financial loss arising from unreasonable flight delays and cancellations; if so, the details thereof?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) what is the current status of implementation of National Action Plans especially in curbing online extremist content; and
- b) whether National Counter Terrorism Authority (NACTA) has been given sufficient resources and authority to ensure coordination to counter with terrorism through efforts made across the Country?

Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state:

- a) whether Government has approved any plan to modernize Air Traffic Management Systems (ATMS) at Jinnah International Airport, Karachi;
- b) if so, the details thereof, including type of air traffic control system to be installed; and
- c) the details of said project cost on the implementation timelines?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that Driving Schools/ Institutions are working in the Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT), if so, the details thereof;
- b) how many schools/ institutions are working with details of their staff, address and criteria for establishing these schools/ institutions;
- c) whether all such schools/ institutions have been taken permission from I.T.P and other related departments;
- d) whether it is also a fact that the IQRA Driving School has not taken any permission from relevant departments; and
- e) whether token tax of their vehicles (which are used for training) are charged as commercial or otherwise?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state the number of Computerized National Identity Cards (CNIC) found fake and same rejected belonging to Afghans during the last five years?

180. * MS. SOFIA SAEED SHAH

Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has assessed the impact of the proviso to Section 9 of the Employees' Old-Age Benefits Act, 1976, under which EOBI contributions cease at the age of sixty years for men and fifty-five years for women;
- b) whether the Government considers that the lower contribution age for women reduces their contributory service, affects the accumulation of EOBI contributions, and is detrimental to their long-term social security benefits; if not, the basis of such assessment;
- c) the rationale and legal basis for prescribing different ages for men and women;
- d) whether the Government proposes to amend the law to prescribe a uniform age; if not, the reasons therefor; and
- e) the total amount contributed by the Federal Government to the Employees' Old-Age Benefits Institution (EOBI) since the enactment of the Act in 1976, together with the year-wise details and any outstanding Government liability, if applicable?

Will the Minister for Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

- a) whether employees of private television channels are facing prolonged salary delays or non-payment;
- b) if so, the names of channels involved, duration and scale of delays and complaints received from media workers;
- c) whether Pakistan Electronic Media Regulatory Authority (PEMRA) or other authorities have taken notice of above including any inspections, directives, or penalties have been imposed;
- d) what legal safeguards, licensing conditions, financial viability checks, and enforcement mechanisms exist to ensure timely payment of salaries; and
- e) what further corrective steps are being taken by the Government to protect media workers?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA), under the supervision of a Judicial Magistrate, conducted a raid at the Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS), Islamabad and arrested officials allegedly involved in issuing fake Medico Legal Certificates (MLCs);
- b) if so, the names, designations and responsibilities of the accused persons, the allegations against each of them and the present status of the investigation and trial; and
- c) whether fake Medico Legal Certificates (MLCs) were allegedly being issued in exchange for bribes and used for the registration of false criminal cases; if so, the details thereof?

183. * DR. SHARMILA FARUQUI

Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has assessed the number of overseas Pakistanis potentially affected by the new travel rules barring entry with expired or invalid NICOPs, given NADRA data showing total registered identity holders at approximately 222 million with thousands of NICOPs expiring monthly;
- b) whether the new QR code enabled NICOP with enhanced security features has been fully rolled out to facilitate faster verification;
- c) what specific measures are being taken through NADRA facilitation desks at 10 centres abroad and the Pak ID mobile app to ensure overseas Pakistanis can expedite NICOP renewal with fees ranging from \$20 to \$40 depending on provided timeline; and
- d) what communication strategy exists to prevent the confusion and fake news" reported by the Government spokesperson regarding these rules?

Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has any policy to promote the recruitment and employment of female pilots in the cockpit crew of airlines operating in Pakistan;
- b) if not, whether the Government proposes to make it mandatory for all commercial airlines to ensure that at least 5% of cockpit crew positions are filled by female pilots; and
- c) if so, the timeframe for implementation and the measures proposed to achieve this target?

185. * JAM ABDUL KARIM BIJAR

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) the names and legal status of all restaurants, cafés, food outlets and other commercial establishments operating in Margalla Hills National Park and Shakarparian;
- b) whether each operates under a valid lease, licence, concession or contract with the CDA or any other authority;
- c) if so, the approving authority, statutory provision conferring such power; tenure, consideration and annual revenue recovered;
- d) whether the approving authority was legally competent to authorize commercial activity in the said protected areas;
- e) whether approvals regarding above are conformed with the CDA Ordinance, the ICT zoning laws, the Islamabad Nature Conservation and Wildlife Management Act, the Master Plan, environmental laws and court directions;
- f) whether any establishment has encroached beyond the approved area or damaged the forests, trees, wildlife or biodiversity; if so, the action taken so far; and
- g) whether the Government proposes to audit all such establishments and remove unauthorized ones?

Will the Minister for Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has prescribed policy guidelines, codes of conduct or content standards for television dramas and entertainment programmes to ensure conformity with the cultural, moral and social values of Pakistan and the injunctions of Islam;
- b) whether the Government has assessed complaints that certain television dramas depict violence, criminal behaviour, smoking, consumption of intoxicants and family conflicts in a manner inconsistent with such values;
- c) if so, the findings and action taken thereon;
- d) whether the display of on-screen disclaimers or captions stating that smoking is injurious to health and the consumption of intoxicants (alcohol) is prohibited (Haram) is considered sufficient compliance with the applicable laws, regulations and content standards for broadcasting scenes depicting smoking and the consumption of intoxicants; if so, the legal basis thereof, and
- e) whether the Government proposes to review and strengthen the existing regulatory framework and enforcement mechanism; if so, the details thereof?

- a) the complete details and reasons for the one rank decline of the Pakistani passport in the new global rankings; and

Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state:

- a) the details of the terms and conditions under which the said Airbus A310-300 was leased for dispatch abroad;
- b) whether the lease agreement was duly approved by the Board of Directors of PIA and other competent forums; and
- c) if so, the details of such approvals and the lease agreement?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) the names, locations and legal status of all paid, managed or commercial parking areas operating in Islamabad;
- b) whether each such parking facility has been authorized by the CDA or any other authority;
- c) if so, the approving authority, statutory provision under which such authority was exercised, tenure, area allotted, terms and conditions, contractor details and revenue recovered;
- d) whether such approvals comply with the CDA Ordinance, ICT zoning regulations, Islamabad Master Plan, environmental laws and court directions;
- e) whether the use of such land for parking is permissible under the applicable legal framework;
- f) whether any parking facility has expanded beyond the authorized area, encroached upon public or forest land, caused tree cutting, environmental degradation;
- g) the obstruction of public access, as verified through inspections, GIS records, satellite/drone imagery or Google Maps; and
- h) the action taken against any unauthorized parking facility?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government has taken notice of the reported mass death of fish in Rawal Lake, Islamabad, recently; if so, the causes thereof;
- b) whether any scientific investigation and water quality assessment have been conducted to determine the presence of sewage, industrial effluents, toxic substances or other pollutants; if so, the findings thereof;
- c) whether the water supplied from Rawal Lake to the residents of Islamabad and Rawalpindi has been declared safe for human consumption; if so, the basis thereof;
- d) the departments and agencies responsible for the protection and monitoring of Rawal Lake, together with the action taken against those found responsible for the pollution; and
- e) the remedial and preventive measures, together with timelines, devised by the Government to restore the ecological health of Rawal Lake and prevent recurrence of such incidents?

Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:

- a) the practical steps being taken by the Government for the rehabilitation, shelter, food, education, healthcare and employment of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) relocated from the affected areas of District Kurram, along with the total amount expended thereon;
- b) whether the government can confirm that practical work on ground has been carried out as a result of the funds allocated for IDPs;
- c) the number of families provided financial assistance so far and the amount disbursed per family;
- d) the stipulated timeline for the return, rehabilitation, and resettlement of the affected persons;
- e) the latest data available with the Government regarding the total number of IDPs and their current requirements; and
- f) whether the Government intends to carry out on-site monitoring and a third-party audit of the ongoing projects for IDPs to ensure genuine relief rather than mere paperwork?

- c) whether the Government periodically reviews eligibility and retention of Official Passports to prevent misuse or unauthorized retention, and the findings of the latest review;
- d) whether the existing policy is consistent with the principles of transparency, equality before law, fiscal prudence and curbing VIP culture;
- e) the measures being adopted to improve the international standing and visa-free access of Pakistan's Ordinary (Green) Passport;
- f) whether any audit or monitoring mechanism exists to ensure Official Passports are used solely for official purposes; and
- g) the number withdrawn, cancelled or surrendered passports during the last five years due to expiry of entitlement or violation of the applicable rules?

Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that there is a prolonged uncertainty in the Gulf, where approximately 50% of Pakistan's total annual remittances originate and which hosts over 6 million Pakistani workers;
- b) how the Ministry has assessed the potential impact of the current regional tensions on employment stability, wage growth and remittances inflows, especially considering the State Bank of Pakistan's cautious outlook on the external account;
- c) whether remittances have grown 8.6% to 41.6 billion dollars during the Financial Year 2026;
- d) what specific contingency plans and welfare measures have been developed to support overseas workers and their families in case of widespread job losses or repatriation; and
- e) what proactive diplomatic strategy is the Ministry pursuing with Gulf Governments and employees to secure continued employment and ensure fair treatment for Pakistani workers amid escalating tensions?

- a) whether it is a fact that retired military personnel and their families are entitled to get free medical treatment in military hospitals;
- b) whether in emergency cases in the AFIC and Fauji Foundation hospitals they have to make advance payments for their dues in case of heart and other chronic diseases/laboratory tests/instruments like stents which are costly and not affordable by the retired personnel which, however, are later reimbursed; and
- c) if the answer to part (a) above is in affirmative, whether Government intends to give medical treatment to the entitled retired army personnel and their families without advance payments in case of emergency, heart and other chronic diseases/ laboratory fees etc?

- b) whether it is a fact that also the many CNICs of District Dir Lower have been blocked and now are 1978, old record or maternal/paternal grandfather/grandmother's CNIC is being asked by National Database and Registration Authority (NADRA) for restoration whereas providing this record is not an easy task; and
- c) if so, whether any leniency would be exercised in this policy?
