

Islamabad, the 18th July, 2006

No. F. 13(43)/2003-P.A.—In supersession of this Ministry's letter No.F.13(43)/2003-PA, dated the 11th October, 2005, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the following terms and conditions to which the Parliamentary Secretaries shall be entitled with effect from the 1st July, 2006:

1. Salary: ⁵ Rs. 150000/-
Rs. 17,250/- per month (as admissible to a Member of Parliament).
2. Honorarium: Rs. 12,700/- per month.
3. Sumptuary Allowance: Rs. 5,000/- per month (as admissible to a Member of Parliament).
4. Daily Allowance: ⁴ Rs. 3000/- = ⁹ Rs. 4,800/-
Rs. 1000/- per day during the period of residence on duty (as admissible to a Member of Parliament). ^{45 (special) and} Rs. 2,800/- Per day (ordinary)
5. Conveyance Allowance: ³ Rs. 2000/-
There will be no deduction of the allowance of ^{Rs. 750/-} per day which was being drawn by them as Members of Parliament.
6. Travelling Allowance: (i) If travelling by rail, one AC class fare plus one second class fare by shortest route.
(ii) If travelling by air, one business class air fare plus one hundred and fifty rupees.
(iii) If travelling by road ⁷ Rs. 10/- ^{Rs. 5/-} per kilometer by the shortest route.
7. Housing Allowance: Rs. 2000/- per day during the period of residence on duty (as admissible to a Member of Parliament).
8. Telephone Facilities at office/residence: Telephone facility in the office to a limit of ten thousand rupees per month and installation of telephone at the residence at Islamabad at Government expense and exemption of rental and payment of charges of calls upto a maximum of five thousand rupees per month.

9. Telephone Allowance: (Constituency) Rs.10,000/- per month (as admissible to a Member of Parliament).
10. Office Maintenance Allowance: Rs. 8,000/- per month (as admissible to a Member of Parliament).
11. Staff Car: 1300 CC Car with 360 litres of petrol per month subject to the following conditions:
- (i) The Parliamentary Secretaries are also allowed to use staff car beyond the municipal limits of Islamabad within the prescribed ceiling of 360 litres of petrol per month. For this purpose PSO Fleet Cards issued to them can be used anywhere in the country for obtaining petrol.
 - (ii) They will hire private driver for the journey conducted outside Islamabad at their own.
 - (iii) They will be responsible for the restitution of any damage caused to the official car in the event of any accident that occurs during journey outside Islamabad.
 - (iv) No TA/DA will be allowed to the staff/driver accompanying the Parliamentary Secretaries during their journey outside Islamabad.
 - (v) Cost of petrol beyond prescribed ceiling of 360 litres per month would be borne by the Parliamentary Secretaries themselves.

14. Other Facilities: Same as admissible to a Member of Parliament.

2. The Parliamentary Secretaries occupying the official, Government or rented accommodation shall not be entitled to housing allowance of Rs.2000/- per day during the period of their residence on duty in Islamabad.

3. The Terms and Conditions as applicable to the Parliamentary Secretaries of the National Assembly shall also be applicable to Chairmen of Standing Committees of the Parliament.
